Dear Parents / Carers,

Last week the Government shared their plans for potential phased reopening of schools for pupils in Years Reception, 1 and 6 from 1st June. We will be carrying out risks assessments to decide how reopening will work for our school. I will then be in further contact with more information about the possible phased reopening of school for these year groups next week once all risk assessments have been completed.
